From the Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

My homily for the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time was in regard to the deprecatory prayers that should be said by each and every catholic for the protection and defense against the

attacks and temptations of evil spirits. If you would like to listen to it you may go to our website or YouTube.

I need to offer one correction/clarification. Deprecatory prayers are those types of prayers against evil that either seek the aid of the Lord and the saints and angels, or personal rejections of particular evils. The prayer that I mentioned in the homily was of the second type. For example: "In the name of Jesus Christ, I reject and rebuke the sin/evil of....(state the evil you are rejecting)." This prayer is powerful when said by the person who abides in the State of Grace.

However, as I mentioned in the homily, I recommend you say these kinds of prayers even if you are not in the State of Grace. Even though the prayers will not have the power of the Holy Spirit behind them for the person in mortal sin, the act of praying them is important for the continued growth and improvement of our nature, which is so inclined to sin and discouragement. Saying your prayers makes it easier to return to Confession and strengthens you next time you are in the State of Grace.

Now, while in mortal sin, the individual should not attempt to say imprecatory prayers. These prayers actually command the demons to leave, by the power of Christ Jesus within you. If one were to attempt imprecatory prayers while outside of the State of Grace it would leave them vulnerable to attacks from the enemy. Presuming that you are in the State of Grace (after having gone to Confession you are currently unaware of any Mortal Sins on your conscience) you are free to pray imprectory prayers for those persons and things over which you have authority (spouses, children, property and possessions).

It is important to note that you are forbidden from saying imprecatory prayers for people that are possessed by demons. This right is reserved to the bishops and those priests whom they appoint as exorcists. Never attempt to command a demon in these circumstances or in those situations where you do not have authority. These laws are very important and the demons know them and follow them.


